



## RATIFICATION OF TE PATUKIRIKIRI POST-SETTLEMENT GOVERNANCE ENTITY

The mandated negotiators for Te Patukirikiri have been negotiating with the Crown since 2009 in relation to the customary interests of Te Patukirikiri. This has involved negotiations with the Tāmaki Collective of iwi/hapū, the Hauraki Collective of iwi and for our iwi specific interests throughout the rohe.

With the nearing of completion of the Treaty settlement process, the people of Te Patukirikiri have the opportunity to vote on resolutions for the post-settlement governance entity that will administer the Treaty settlement redress. To assist with informed voting, the following ratification hui will be held to present information on, discuss, and vote on the Te Patukirikiri Iwi Trust resolutions:

The two resolutions to be voted on are as follows:

1. *I, as a member of Te Patukirikiri, agree that the Te Patukirikiri Iwi Trust will be the post-settlement governance entity and the recipient of Te Patukirikiri Treaty settlement assets.*
2. *I, as a member of Te Patukirikiri, agree that the interim trustees for Te Patukirikiri Iwi Trust will be;*

  - (iv) STEWART KONUI PETERS
  - (v) JANE HEMO ANTHONY

All registered adult members (aged 18 years or older) of Te Patukirikiri are eligible to vote. All eligible voters must be in attendance of the above hui to vote. Voting will be by show of hands only. No proxies and no postal ballot/s will be taken.
